Brendan Cullen and Tony Lewis Collaborate with *Latin Lawyer* on *The Guide to Corporate Compliance*, Fifth Edition

The last several years has seen an ever-increasing focus on corruption in Latin America, in part due to major scandals and protests, all of which Latin American governments have had to account for in their corporate liability schemes.
